Nov 28th Mon. Dull. Town round - home at 5oc. Dora arrived home about 2oc.

B. of H. this evening. Letters from Mary & John. What to bid in Dining room at 10.45

Nov 29th Tues. The Arnold's I slept in Dining room last night & I got up at 5.30 -

made some tea & did my chores. I went with Dora to London by 4.7
coach - we arrived at Knightsbridge with just time to have a cup
of tea - after I had left her at 2oc at the Nurse's home, I went
to make a business call in Kensingt. road & returned on the 4.40
coach from Eldon St. arriving home at 6.40. Douglas & Evans
arrive at 10.5. Came up to bed at 11oc.

Nov 29th Tues. Foggy - then fair. Hadham round - home at 1.45.

Arnes & Dora went round Whitehall mother & I went up C. T. Lane
to meet them. Photo from Kay of herself with letter.

Came to bed at 11oc.

Nov 30th Wed. Fair, cool. Broke to Henham - home at 2.50. Mr. Fletcherby came in
supper. Wrote to Dora. Came up to bed at 11.15.

Dec 1st Thurs. Fairly clear - home at 1.30. Arnes & I took Fletcherby

across the fields round Hoggott's Wood - we saw a fox at Hoggott's Wood.

We spoke at Sistebrook this evening - I met her we went to F.O.R. 2ndy.

on Dora. Letters from Kay - wrote to both of them.

Wrote to bed at 11oc.

1939

Dec. 3rd. Sat. Fine. Coal. Started home at 3 o'clock noon. Little Ken in to supper. Came up to bed at 10:35.

Dec. 4th. Sun. Fair. We did not go to church this morning. Wrote to Dora & Kay. Douglas, Keween. Little Ken came in just before we went to church - on our return we found that they had gone - they did not come back tonight. Came up to bed at 10:45.

Dec. 5th. Mon. Fine. Town - home at 5 o'clock. Brother John here. B. of H.

Came up to bed at 7:30. Letters from Kay, 1^o from Dora. Letter from John.

Dec. 6th. Tues. Fine. Smooth. - home at 4:30. Mother at Dunmore Gaile this afternoon. Mother wrote to Dora. Honore wrote to Kay.

Came up to bed at 11:00

Dec. 7th. Wed. Fair. Did return Reg. Bonnell in this morning. This afternoon I walked round tooght's wood - Arnold's cold not being better, he did not come with me. Proctor in to supper. Letter from Kay, wrote a P.C to her. Came up to bed at 10:30.

Dec. 8th. Thurs. ^{Cloudy, dull all day} Newport, home at 2:45. Arnold's cold not gone yet, so he has stayed in bed all day. Listened tonight to Broadcast appeal by Earl Baldwin on behalf of Jewish Refugee fund: we find that we would like to offer to take a child. Mrs. Maynard in this evening. Came up to bed at 10:30.

Dec. 9th. Fri. Fine until late afternoon, then rain. Washed floors in morning.
Met Dora & Kay off coach at 10c. Drove M.G. at Holford this afternoon - took
bus from there to Widford - met Mr. Holford by appointment. Then went
to Widford Chapel to service held by two Faith Missionaries - home at
9.45. Came up to bed at 11.15. Mother & the girls still downstairs.

Dec. 10th. Sat. Fair. Started - home at 12.45. Kay arrived about 5oc.

Dora & Kay met local station. Mr. Rawles & the two
Lady Missionaries here to tea - left about 7oc. Douglas,
Kevans, Gordon & Luke here in this way. Too much
noise for me, so brought work upstairs & in bed at 7oc.

Dec. 11th. Sun. Fair. We did not go to church today. Derry arrived at 10.45.

This afternoon Gordon, Ken Luke came to tea. Kevans came after tea.

Mother, Dora & I went to Station & saw Kay off by the 10.55 to Norwich.

Came up to bed at 11.35.

Dec. 12th. Mon. Fair. Town - home at 4.45. Mother & I saw Dora & Kay off by 11.15 coach this
morning. Letter from John. B. of N.Y. Dora addressed the mtg. 29 children present.

Came up to bed at 10.30

Dec. 13th. Tues. Fair. Mild - Hadham & Shering - home at 3oc. Mother & Arnold walked
to Whitehall - went to meet them. did return. Proctor came in this way.
for a short time. Came up to bed at 11oc. P.C. from Kay.

Dec. 14th. Wed. Mainly fair - some rain. Went to Wimham this morning. Daniels returns & continued writing, now collecting took. Mother was going to Wilford this evening, but as it turned out a foul, foggy damp night, she stayed in wrote to Dora, Kay & Millie. We listened in to "Band wagon".

P.C. this morning from Dora - came up to bed at 10:30.

Dec. 15th. Thurs. Foggy, then fine. Visited Wimham - home at 10c. Mother, Arnold & I walked round Whittleall. wrote to Dora & Mary. Mother at Choir practice. Dorothy, Matilda, & Mrs. Jackson to to supper. Dorothy left at 12:10. Came up to bed at 11:25.

Dec. 16th. Fri. Rain all day this evening. Takely & Elsham - home at 2:30 - wet. Letter from Kay, wrote to her & to Dora. Came up to bed at 11:30 - light at 12:20.

Dec. 17th. Sat. Fair cold. Stansted - home at 3:00. Letter from Dora. Nobody came in this evening. Came up to bed at 11:5.

Dec. 18th. Sun. Mainly fair, drizzling, with bitterly cold wind - Mother at church this morning. Isaw her off to Wilford this afternoon & met her just before 5:00 on her return - I did not go to Wilford this evening as intended, as the chapel keeps thought that nobody would be there. Mother, Arnold & I - Coral Room - in our church this evening. Gordon came at 4:00 & stayed to tea & afterwards went to the Methodist Church. Nobody came in this evening. I wrote to Dora & Kay. Took letter to P.C. not before 10:00. I was going to light a fire in the girls' room for Arnold, but did not do so, as the wind

We had chicken for dinner. Went out to go to Wed Ford this afternoon to take Mother's S.S. but found the buses were not running. Luke came in after tea - Mr. McChesney Arnold & Luke did chores. Came up to bed at 10^o.

Dec. 26th Mon. Mother, Kay, Arnold I set out in a snowstorm for Dulwich, and arrived there at 12:30. We had Xmas dinner & present, besides ourselves, John, Millie, Marjorie, Donald, Mary, Betty, Rev. Mrs. Copeland. We called on Hg. Mrs. Then went to St. George's Hospital, racing them at 5^o. Dora took us round some of the wards afterwards came with us to the Corner House - we left her at 7:45 - Caught the 8:22 train from Liverpool St. arrived home at 9:30. We soon had supper upstairs by the gas fire, & I lit the fire in the girls room over listening to a very lively good Dance Band - Joe Loo's.

Dec. 27th Tues. Mainly fine. Thaw set in last night - did most of my Monday work round home about 3^o. Dora arrived at 7^o. We all went to the Charles to tea. Came up to bed at 11:30. Case of canaries today from Walter Louisa.

Dec. 28th Wed. John Hadham round finished Merton Town road - home at 3:15. Dora returned. Dora gone. saw Kay off to Norwich this morning by 9:20 train. Peggy soon in to tea. Dora went to London by 5:35 train to meet Raines. Arnold at flicks with Kelly other home with him - returned at 10:15. I am put off to meet Dora who arrives at 11:45. Father wrote to Kay.

1938

Dec. 29th. Thurs. Fair morn, rain in afternoon turning. Hinham road - home at 4oc. - wrt. Howells birthday: birthday card from Kathleen & letter to the family. This has been one of our extra Special Kill-Quicks lately days. I met Dora at the station at 11M. rather late oc. in the bedroom, it was about 2oc. when the light was put out. We got up late this morn. & Eddie not start out until 11oc. I arrived home not that he change. When I started home, I found Peggy & Fanny Ballard, Peggy Swan, Mrs. Charles & George Kelly just to the door. Jeanne called in later; but only stayed a minute. Peggy phoned for a friend of hers at Taunby, who came on later with his saxophone. I'm afraid the Saxophone is not designed for Music. I have been writing my hair combing fork. In the evening, the A.T. man came in during the evening - I am writing this at 10.35 - I hope the Saxophone Chaps & Peggy will depart soon, so that I can lay my weary body in bed. - Peggy & the Saxophone took left at 10.30 and I have come up to bed - the others are downstairs. Dora goes home with Peggy. - Dora arrived back at 12oc.

Dec. 30th. Fri. Fair - Hinham - home at 1.15. Howells had two teeth extracted this afternoon by gas by Mr. Dodd - Dr. Holmes in attendance.

Arnold saw Dora off by 11.17 coach to London. Mother wrote to her this evening - wrote to May. Came up to bed at 10⁰c.

Dec. 31st. Sat. Fair, fine intervals. Letter from Dora saying that she is coming home again next Thursday. Slepted round, home at 4⁰c. Mother gave a lift this afternoon to her Wiford S.S. children at Wiford & I met her off the bus on her return at 7.30. Arnold at Kelly's this afternoon - he reached home about 8⁰c. Came up to bed at 11.5 - the old year will soon be out. Much to be thankful for in 1938 - Kathleen settled in her first post, & Dora in training for Hospital Nurse.

1939. Sun.
Jan 1st. Mainly fine, up too late for morning service, but went to communion service - Mother at Wiford 10 children - Gordon in this afternoon stayed to tea, Kelly also came in but did not stay to tea. Went to Wiford this evening - 2 women 1 man & a child present. Mother out to Bunting - Mr.ings took her. Lure then came in about 6⁰c. octagonal until 6.45 - Farmer called after supper upon I got home but would not stay - wrote to May this afternoon & brought wireless into our bedroom at 10.30. No news Dora, listening now to the Spelopne story going into bed.

Jan 2nd. Mon. Cloudy - snowshowers in afternoon - Town round - home about 5.30. with Sanders on bus in evening - L. Hellingbury Town. Arnold at Kelly's this afternoon. Letters from May & John. Douglas in to tea. Came up to bed at 11⁰c.

Jany. 3rd. into Fin. Sworth Harbor - home at 5:30. Peggy Ballard & Miss Moon here to tea
they did not leave until 10:30. Peggy talking all the time. Supper in the
kitchen before the fire this - then to bed at 11:30.

Jany. 4th. 2nd. Snow fell during the night till all day - did not go. Arnold & I went
out for a walk this afternoon, but as it was not nice walking, we only
went to the end of Barrels Down. wrote to Dora this morning. She came
in this evening. Came up to bed with the wireless at 10:45.

Jany. 5th. Rained. Mainly Fine. Cold - Airport - home at 3:30. Dora packed home between
3:45 & 4:30. Peggy Swan in this evening. Wrote to Mary, Alice & John. Conception
at 7:00. with the wireless.

Jany. 6th. Dr. Fin. cold. Farnham farm - continued writing new collecting book.

Mother, Dora, Arnold & I walked round Whitehall this afternoon.

Arnold & Dora at Peggy Swan's to tea. Gordon Swan in this evening.

Came up to bed at 10:45. Others still downstairs. Letter from Ray.

Jany. 7th. Sat. Drizzle & dull. Started home at 3:00. The most difficult day this season
for travelling, as except for the main roads, the roads were extremely
slipping - the snow having been frozen over. Ray arrived at 4:30.

Doctor Morris here this afternoon & this evening. Mr. Luke also

Came. Sally Reed & her fiance should have come, but probably
were prevented by the weather. Mother & I came upstairs about 7:00

- the boys left at 11.45.

Jany 8th. Sun. Fair, much warmer. Dora returned to London by 11.27 coach. Mother went to Smooth brotherhood for me this afternoon. Went to take her 5.5. class at 2.15. 11 children & 2 adults present - I stayed for the evening service - 3 boys & woman present. Kay returned to Norwich by the 4.30 train. Howard went to Kelly's stayed to tea, returning about 8.20. I reached home at 7.40. Samson came in to supper - at 10.15 when we were coming up to bed, Rector, Kraus & Gordon came in, but only stayed 10 mins. wrote to Walter.

Jany. Mon. Main Fair, Mild. Town-hall at 5.15. Mother started supply work at H. Heath School - home at 4.30. D. G. H. taught us for the children a total - shorts & cakes after games - we took a Xmas tree with us. Rose Knight - our worst girl whom we have always regarded as invincible gave Dora a box of choc. & the girl.

Waterson gave her a rummer for the dressing-table - both these were beautiful surprises. Letter from John.

Howard went to Kelly's to tea & afterward to the Hicks' home up to bed at 10.35.

Jany. Tues. Fair, Weather home at 1.15 until about 2. Home at 3. Met Main Town on her return from School - Rector went to school for her at 4.15 found she had left about 4.10. Another boy went back to town, also Howard, Rector in to tea. Mrs. Waterson in to supper. Letter from Dora to Kay. Anne wrote to Kay, wrote to Dora. Came up to bed at 11.00.

Jany. 11th. Wed. Fine, did return. Dthy. Dorothy came in at 11:45 & cooked dinner - she left about 4:00. Inst. mother at Rockville coming from school at 4:15. Dthy. came to tea at 5:00, stayed to supper. Arnold at Kelly's to tea. Came up to bed at 11:00.

Jany. 12th. Thurs. Fine. Broke fast at 7:30 - home at 2:45. Dthy. Dorothy cooked dinner. Mother at Chor. practice, Dthy. returned with her to supper. wrote to Mary. John & Mr. Britton. Came up to bed at 11:20.

Jany. 13th. Fri. Fine. Dorothy Elsenham - home at 1:45. Dorothy Dorothy had got the dinner ready. Arnold & I took Dthy's dog across the fields - very muddy. Doctor in from 4:30 to 6:00. Mr. Langmaid came in this evening. wrote to Dona Kathleen P.C. Grandpa this morning. Came up stairs & had tea & toast at 10:20.

Jany. 14th. Sat. Fair during day. Rain at night. Started - home at 2:30.

Kelly home to dinner. Arnold went with him to a football match then to his to tea, returning home about 9:00. Two Faith Missionaries here to tea. Dorothy sat Mother an electric torch this afternoon - I called to thank her. Letter from Kay - came up to bed at 10:30. Not still downstairs.

Jany. 15th. Sun. Fair - rain tonight. Dad's birthday - Mother Arnold to church this morning. Dorothy into dinner. Mother to S.S. at Wildwood. Arnold was expecting Kelly to come to tea, but his bro. Sam came to say that George wasn't very well so he took Arnold back with him & brought him home at 8:00. Dthy. not home this afternoon & returned to tea; she what with Mother to, fragments - Mother

brought the stories there. Donald arrived - returned at 7:45 +
 found Mother & Dthy. home. Dthy. stayed to supper home until at 10:00.
 Jan 16th Mon. Rainy day - some showers. Tom round home at 4:30. The Missionaries

Went back to Lawrence's - left at 4:45. Douglas & Gordon in this evening - they left at 11:30.

Feb. 6th. Mon. Fair. Dispart of Tom rowd & caught 'bus at 1.10 to attend Herts County
Union Mtg. at Har. Mr. Peacock brought Mrs. Turner, Mrs. Rankin one hour:
